CLEVELAND HEIGHTS - UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM



The Board of Education has authorized the organization of a tuition based summer school for students residing in the Cleveland Heights - University Heights City School District currently enrolled in grades six through twelve. Information about summer school classes and enrollment is available from each Middle School and High School Counselor.

SUMMER SCHOOL CURRICULUM: The Middle School courses offered during summer school are delivered through face-to-face instruction. The High School courses offered in summer school utilize a "blended learning" approach. This style offers self-paced computer instruction supported by academic and support staff. Students will be provided with computers to use during class. High school Physical Education and Health courses will be offered in a face-to-face setting. Students can take P.E. and Health courses during summer school to fulfill their P.E. and Health graduation requirements.

LENGTH OF SESSION: Summer school classes will take place Monday-Thursday. Middle School classes will run for 5 weeks, from June 12- July 13. High School classes will run for 6 weeks from June 12- July 20. There will be no classes on Tuesday, July 4, 2017.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Begin the registration process by completing the online registration form or contacting your Middle School or High School counselor. Counselors will review the registration forms and students will be notified by the Summer School principals of their courses. Payment should be made through the Infinite Campus parent portal by June 13th 2017. Classes with registration of fewer than twenty students may be canceled. Course information will be listed in Infinite Campus by June 9th. **Registration closes June 8th, 2017.**

<u>TUITION</u>: Summer School tuition is \$100 per class with a maximum of \$200. Tuition includes most course materials. Students are typically required to provide general school supplies as required by the teacher (i.e. pens, pencils, paper, notebook, etc.).

<u>PAYMENTS/REFUNDS:</u> Cash, money orders and payment through the Infinite Campus Portal will be accepted. Please make money orders payable to THE CLEVELAND HEIGHTS-UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS BOARD OF EDUCATION. Payment can be made through the Infinite Campus Parent Portal after a student has been registered or PAID IN PERSON IN THE MAIN OFFICE OF THE HIGH SCHOOL. Payment of tuition in full is a requirement for registration and must be received by May 26th. No refunds will be issued unless caused by the district cancelling the course.

LOCATION: All 2017 Summer School classes will be held at **Monticello Middle School**, located at 3665 Monticello Blvd, Cleveland Heights, OH 44121.

TRANSPORTATION: Transportation to and from Summer School is the responsibility of the students and parents.

<u>ATTENDANCE/TARDY</u>: Attendance is MANDATORY. More than two (2) absences from a course for any reason will be grounds for dismissal from the program.

<u>SENIOR</u> <u>GRADUATION</u>: The Summer School Graduation for Seniors will take place after state test results and completion of graduation requirements are confirmed. Additional information will be provided to graduating seniors as plans are finalized.

<u>STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:</u> All Board of Education and High School rules and regulations will be enforced during Summer School.

DRESS GUIDELINES: Attire that is not in compliance with the dress code policy is not permitted. In addition to the clothing items expressly prohibited under the policy, principals and staff have discretion to address any attire that is offensive, degrading and vulgar, and that disrupts the learning environment or infringes upon the rights of others.
