As the fourth quarter fast approaches, the 8th grade team would like to share the plans for our 8th grade end-of-the-year activities. Below are the planned events with criteria associated with individual events or activities:

8th Grade Dance: Students who have not received more than 2 referrals during the 4th quarter, have not been suspended during the 4th quarter, are passing all classes by progress report time during the 4th quarter and have paid all fees are eligible to attend the 8th grade dance on Friday, May 24th. The attire is semi-formal and price TBA. The event will begin at 6pm with a catered dinner from 6-7pm. The dance will have a professional DJ who will start at 7 and conclude at 9pm. Tickets will be made available through our online payment system via Infinite Campus beginning the start of 4th quarter. Refunds will not be provided if a student becomes ineligible due to referrals or suspension. Only HMS students in grade 8 can attend.

Superlatives/Slideshow: During the last week of school, 8th grade HMS students will watch the slideshow and receive superlative awards from student voting.

Cedar Point: Any 8th grade student who has not received more than 2 referrals during the 4th quarter, has had no suspensions during the 4th quarter and is passing all classes for the year by the end of 3rd quarter will have the chance to travel to Cedar Point on May 30th. The cost of the ticket is approximately \$65.00. The cost covers the ticket as well as a lunch wristband that allows your student to drink fountain pops free all day.
