The new first grade learning environment supports multiple site groupings from an assembly of the entire first grade in the commons for morning meeting to a breakout session for 4 students in the small group room. Every inch of space is used for learning - even what used to be the hallway. Technology stations with digital tablets, and window seat reading nooks line the former hallway. Teachers now have a professional environment for their Professional Learning Community to plan and collaborate in the Teacher Collaboration Room.
