Executive Summary – Meeting and Organizational Structure Cleveland Heights – University Heights City School District Citizens' Facilities Committee

Meeting Structure and Organization

The overall Citizens' Facilities Committee ("Committee") will be comprised of a cross section of the community, whose purpose is to analyze the District's facilities needs and develop multiple facilities options for Board consideration. The Committee will be broken down into the following four topic-specific subcommittees that will report to the full Committee at a series of public forums:

- 1. **Building Assessment Subcommittee** (to review and analyze the validity of the OSFC master facilities assessment);
- 2. **Educational Assessment Subcommittee** (to review and analyze learning environments and 21st century educational opportunities);
- 3. Facilities Planning Subcommittee (to investigate facilities planning options); and
- 4. **Financial Assessment Subcommittee** (to analyze cost implications of addressing facilities educational needs).

The Building Assessment and Educational Assessment Subcommittees will work concurrently during Fall 2010 to analyze the OSFC facilities assessment and investigate educational practices. These Subcommittees will report back to the full Committee by the end of 2010. Based upon their reports, the Facilities Planning and Financial Assessment Subcommittees will convene in early 2011 to investigate finance options and facilities planning options.
