AWARDS/RECOGNITIONS

Welcome New Superintendent – Dr. Talisa L. Dixon

Board President Ron Register introduced Dr. Talisa Dixon and shared a brief history of her career and educational experience. This is Dr. Dixon's first official role as Superintendent at a regular Board meeting. Dr. Dixon expressed her gratitude for the opportunity to work with the District.

Scott Smith, Fuel and Bus Committees Member, OSC Cooperative Purchasing Program

Dr. Talisa Dixon, Superintendent, recognized Scott Smith, Transportation Supervisor, for saving the District \$455,000 in FY2014. Last year, Scott Smith participated on Ohio School Council's Fuel and Bus Committee and provided invaluable input with ideas on making transportation and its costs more efficient. Dr. Dixon and Board President Register presented Scott with Certificates of Appreciation on behalf of Ohio School Council and the CH-UH School District.

Krista Hawthorne, Executive Director, Reaching Heights

Superintendent Dixon introduced Krista Hawthorne, the new Executive Director of Reaching Heights. Krista has been with Reaching Heights for eight years and is replacing Patrick Mullen as Executive Director. The District welcomed Ms. Hawthorne and looks forward to opportunities for increased learning with our students, staff and communities. Ms. Hawthorne described some of the recent changes to Reaching Heights and highlighted some of the work and goals of the organization.

Closing the Gap

Students of Promise USA Program Director Bob Ivory presented information to the Board on an initiative for targeted youth designed to close the achievement gap. Mr. Ivory is looking forward to implement this pilot program within the District. Students of Promise aims to increase academic achievement for students and promote them to their next grade level through to graduation. Each child in the program would be partnered with a Linkage Coordinator in their school who would act as mentor, role model, monitor, and advocate for the student's success. Staff would be hired by the District and paid through grant funds.

Tiger Up Update

Dr. Jeff Johnston, Director of Student Services, and Kristin Hughes, Director of Athletics, updated the Board on a new program to enhance and develop the character of student athletes and coaches in our District, the **Tiger Up** initiative. Part of this initiative will be a drug-testing program intended to take the pressure off students by providing them with a legitimate reason to refuse drugs and to create a drug free environment. The proposed population for drug testing would be students in grades 7-12 who participate in athletics and school sponsored clubs and activities. In addition, students who drive a privately owned vehicle to and from school and park on school property would be included in the random student drug testing process. Policy for this program will be presented to the Board for a first reading at an upcoming meeting.
