

**Immunization Requirements for Enrollment**

**2008 – 2009 School Year**

**Kindergarten through Grade 2:**

- 1. Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis:** 4 doses are required
  - Kindergarten: 4 doses of DTaP, DTP or DT are required. If the fourth dose was administered before the fourth birthday, a fifth dose is required.
  - Grades 1 & 2: 4 doses of DTaP, DTP, DT or TD are required. For students age 7 and older, if the third dose is TD or Tdap a fourth dose is **not** required.
- 2. Polio:** 3 doses of all OPV or all IPV are required
  - If the third dose was administered before the 4th birthday, then a fourth dose is required.
  - If the first 3 doses were a combination of OPV and IPV, then a fourth dose is required.
- 3. MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella):** 2 doses are required
  - The first dose must be administered on or after the first birthday.
  - The second dose must be administered at least 28 days after the first dose.
- 4. Hepatitis B:** 3 doses are required
  - The second dose must be administered at least 28 days after the first dose.
  - The third dose must be given at least 16 weeks after the first dose and at least 8 weeks after the second dose.
  - The **last** dose in the series should not be administered before 24 weeks of age (6 months).
- 5. Varicella (chickenpox):** 1dose required
  - Must be administered on or after the first birthday.
  - Children who have had varicella (chickenpox) are not required to be immunized. A signed statement from parent, guardian, or physician attesting to this is required.

**Grades 3 through 12:**

- 1. Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis:** 4 doses are required
  - May be any combination of DTP, DTaP, DT, Tdap or Td.
  - For students age 7 and older, if the third dose is TD or Tdap a fourth dose is **not** required.
- 2. Polio:** 3 doses of all OPV or all IPV are required
  - If the third dose was administered before the 4th birthday, then a fourth dose is required.
  - If the first 3 doses were a combination of OPV and IPV, then a fourth dose is required.
- 3. MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella):** 2 doses are required
  - The first dose must be administered on or after the first birthday.
  - The second dose must be administered at least 28 days after the first dose.
- 4. Hepatitis B:** 3 doses are required **NOT REQUIRED FOR GRADES 10, 11, or 12**
  - The second dose must be administered at least 28 days after the first dose.
  - The third dose must be given at least 16 weeks after the first dose and at least 8 weeks after the second dose.
  - The **last** dose in the series should not be administered before 24 weeks of age (6 months).
