Expectations:

- Attend 1-3 evening or afternoon meetings/activities each month; regular meetings are the third Tuesday of the month – 3:30 p.m. at Heights High
- Learn about the Small School, the students, staff, and parents
- Be willing to compromise and work for consensus
- Be an advocate for the school
- Have and be willing to use community networks
- Believe that all children can learn.

Members serve for two and three year terms.

The 2007-2008 school year will be the fourth year for Small Schools at Cleveland Heights High School. There are five Small Schools, each focusing on a different style of instruction. The goal of the Small Schools program is to improve student achievement – to increase the number of students who graduate, attend college, score well on standardized tests, take the most advanced classes available, participate in leadership programs, and view school as an engaging place to learn.
