The first day of school, **Tuesday**, **August 23**, will be here before you know it. It may be helpful to start planning for the first days of school now.

Below is the general supply list for your scholar's classes:

## **General Supplies for core classes:**

(Core subject teachers will announce which supplies will be used in their classes)

- (1) pair headphones or earbuds
- (1) 3 inch or larger zipper binder **without the expanding file** (to be used as sixth universal binder)
- (1) 3-hole punched pencil pouch to stay in universal binder
- (4) 3-hole punched poly/plastic pocket folders **without prongs** (to be used in universal binder) OR 16
  - 3-hole punched paper pocket folders without prongs (1 for each core class per quarter)
- (4) packages of 24 #2 pencils (one package per quarter)
- (2) pink erasers
