WORK SESSION

Reconfiguration Pre-K to 8th Grade Presentation

Assistant Superintendent Felisha Gould and the Educational Services team led a presentation on the reason change in education design would work best for CH-UH schools. The team recommended changes to the grade reconfigurations for elementary and middle buildings. The new FY20 configuration, which differs from the proposal in the original master facilities plan, would be:

Elementary School – PreK-4 – 7 Buildings Intermediate School – Grades 5-6 – 1 Building Middle School – Grades 7-8 – 1 Building High School – Grades 9-12 – 1 Building Delisle Options – Grades 10-12 – 1 Building

They discussed strategic plan goals and new graduation requirements, and pointed out how these align with the recommended grade reconfiguration. Superintendent Dr. Talisa Dixon acknowledged her support of this recommendation. Board members asked questions and commented on the presentation. Issues were raised by board members and another discussion on this topic is required before the Superintendent moves forward with this recommendation.
