

CH-UH Harassment, Intimidation, or Bullying Incidents 2023-2024 School Year

In compliance with R.C. 3313.666 (B) (10), the District is required to report the number of harassment, intimidation, or bullying incidents. Harassment, intimidation, or bullying means either of the following:

- A. any intentional written, verbal, electronic, or physical act that a student or group of students exhibits toward another particular student(s) more than once and the behavior both causes mental or physical harm to the other student(s) and is sufficiently severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment for the other student(s); or
- B. violence within a dating relationship.

As of the end of the 2023-2024 school year (YTD), the number of harassment, intimidation, or bullying incidents reported by building are indicated below:
