COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS ENROLLMENT FOR TRI-C

NURSES NOTES: IMMUNIZATION UPDATE

Class of 2024: Now is the time to check the status of your Meningococcal A vaccine, which is **required PRIOR to entering 12th grade** and is also required for college. The vaccine could be administered at school during your junior year (as well as during the summer) through the MetroHealth Wellness Center located at Heights High. Documentation of having received the vaccine must be on file in the nurses office prior to staring your senior year!


