HEALTH CLASS LETTER

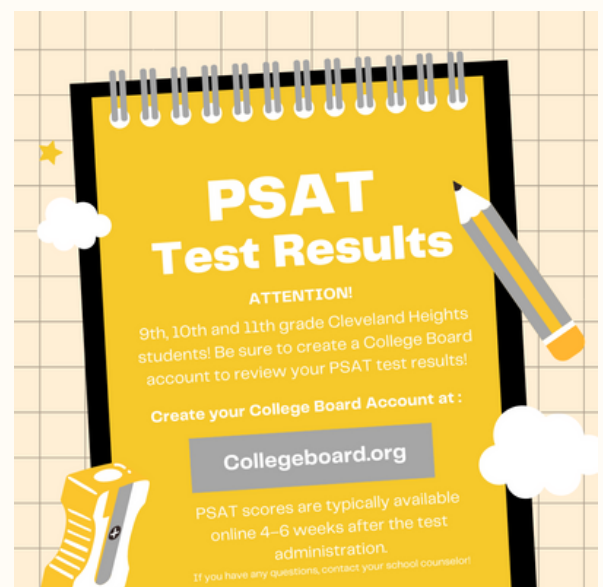
The letter distributed for the upcoming sexual education curriculum must be **returned by ALL students in health class** whether parents are opting their child in or out.
