Kindergarten Supplies* Only label with a name the 1st 4 items

Book Bag - large enough to hold a folder and library books,

Lunch Box (Optional)

Extra clothing labeled with name

Small Headphones

Do NOT put names on the rest

1 box pre-sharpened #2 Ticonderoga

Rest towel (no bigger than a bath towel)

USA-made preferred: have more lead, sharpen better

2 Colored Pens for self-grading (red/green/purple)

12-inch Wooden Ruler (cm. and in. to the ¼ inch)

1 Protractor

2 Spiral Notebooks: yellow (for IB), blue (for Math)

2 Composition Notebooks (non-spiral)

1 pack of 3X5 Index Cards (Ruled)

1 black Sharpie© Marker

1 pair of Scissors

3 Glue Sticks

1 bottle of white Glue

1 pack of Sticky/Post-It Notes
