Statement of purpose: The Theater Designer collaborates with the Technical Director and drama director to aid in developing designs and set pieces for the Drama Club's spring play and the Vocal Music Department's musical.

1. Collaborate with the rest of the design team to design, build and paint set pieces for productions.
2. Finish all projects in a timely manner for use during technical rehearsals for a show.
3. Supervise student crewmembers and help train them as necessary in tool use, painting techniques, theatrical practices always with an eye on safety.
4. Wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment and ensure that students do as well.
5. Take precautions to ensure safety. Helps manage/eliminate risks.
6. Works effectively with limited supervision. Performs tasks efficiently to meet deadlines.
