CH-UH has been looking at the current research on what is termed the “summer loss in learning” and the findings are convincing. Research indicates the following:

- Most young people experience learning losses when they do not engage in educational activities during the summer.
- On average, students lose approximately 2.6 months of grade-level equivalency in mathematical computation skills over the summer months.
- Some students can lose about 2 months of reading achievement.

The good news is 2-3 hours per week of educational activities can help reduce or prevent learning loss.
