Dr. Joseph Micheller, Director of Special Programs/Compliance, responded to comments made during the Public Address regarding the AVID Program. A comprehensive review of the AVID Program was conducted measuring our AVID Program to what the national standards say a good program should have. Our program was found to be lacking. Changes have been put in place to take effect in the 2010-2011 school year. A more formal presentation on the AVID Program will be brought before the Board in September.

Update on Chinese Partnerships and Teaching

Dr. Joe Micheller and Assistant Superintendent Jeff Talbert provided the Board with an update on their recent trip to China. CH-UH CSD was invited to this education delegation because of the innovative nature of our District. Our partnership with Cleveland State University and China provides immediate and long-term benefits for our students to have a quality education and succeed in a global economy. In the summer of 2011, teachers in three participating cities working through the Confucius Institute of Cleveland State University, will participate in a Teacher Emersion Opportunity where they will spend six weeks in China teaching English to Chinese teachers and principals.

Update on Ohio Achievement Assessments and Ohio Graduation Tests Results

Assistant Superintendent Jeff Talbert provided preliminary data on Ohio Achievement assessments and Ohio Graduation Test results. Mr. Talbert stated that official results would not be available until August 24th. Areas of concern at this point include Science and Math at all grade levels, and Reading at most grade levels. At the regular Board meeting in September, a report will be given to the Board with an overall review of our data and our plans to address the issues that are found.
