Superintendent Deborah Delisle provided the Board of Education with an update on the beginning of the current school year. Mrs. Delisle congratulated all staff, families and administrators on a smooth start. Each of the buildings welcomed new and returning students warmly, and many positive comments were heard on the smooth opening of school.

Superintendent Delisle also thanked the grounds crew, painters, cleaners and custodians for ensuring every building was clean and ready for students and staff to return. Mrs. Delisle visited every building on the first day of school. She thanked the central office administrators for their visits to and assistance at each school.

Several of our elementary and middle schools will be participating in an event called "Fathers Walk 2008." This event is sponsored by the PASSAGES Organization of Cleveland and occurs on Wednesday, September 10. Our District's fathers, grandfathers, uncles, cousins and big brothers are being invited to support this event.

Superintendent Delisle expressed congratulations to Jeff Glass, one of our high school teachers, for becoming certified as an Apple Final Cut Pro instructor. Mr. Glass will be recognized at an upcoming Board meeting.

The results from our local report card were released from the Ohio Department of Education. Superintendent Delisle applauded our schools that continue to meet their goal. However, she expressed disappointment that our District was just shy of meeting the Effective rating. The District did see positive movement in eleven testing areas, but the growth was not enough to move the entire

District forward. Overall, the District's ranking was Continuous Improvement. Further details will be given at the October Board work session.
